Specially chosen to suit beef in all its guises, the wines all deliver good tannins (savoury and gamey), medium to full bodied weight & real character. Our new house pouring beef recommendation is a rich, super-charged Carmenere which over delivers. A grape variety that was for years found to be languishing in the shadows and in amongst the vines of the Merlot grape, it has seen a remarkable rejuvenation.

Stunning Crianza from one of the new stars of the region crafted in a traditional style but with a delicious fragrant and fresh angle.

Fantastic, a blend of six grapes, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenere, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Petit Verdot. Medium bodied. Dry.

Stunning purity of fruit with big flavours and savoury tannins. This wine is made for beef.

Fresh and fruity with tropical fruit aromas followed by some floral notes. The long crisp finish will make you want more.

Light bodied, but intensely refreshing! Delicate orchard fruits mix well with citrus fragrances.

Soft and aromatic, with a chocolaty texture and notes of ripe strawberry and liquorice.
- The Southerly Shiraz – Bin 16** £27.50
The Lane, South Eastern, Australia
Juicy forest fruits mingle with dark chocolate and spice to give a hidden depth to this shiraz.
